Thank you for participating in our middle school basketball program! We are so excited to have our middle school sports program. Thank you for allowing your child to participate, as it is a lot of fun! <a href="The-creation-needed-to-color: blue-color: "The CR Anderson Sports Program is to provide equal and safe opportunities for all students to participate." Our focus is to foster competition, sportsmanship, teamwork, and individual improvement.

<u>Team Placement:</u> The 6th and 7th-grade team placement will be on Tuesday, December 5th, Wednesday, December 6th, and Thursday, December 7th. These three days we will practice from 3:00-4:00 PM. The 7th graders will meet in the lower gym and the 6th graders will be in the upper gym. Teams will be posted on Friday, December 8th. Our goal is to make the teams as even as possible. <u>The students will need to pay attention to their coach, practice time, and gym.</u> These are <u>final</u> teams and we will not make any changes after this time. <u>Please make sure that your child knows the time, place, and coach!</u> It is very important that your child listens to school announcements for any basketball information.

<u>Practices:</u> We start practices with assigned teams on Tuesday, December 12th. We normally practice Tuesday- Friday. Your child may have practice at 3:00, 4:00, or 5:00 PM. All practices are Tuesday through Friday and will remain the same all season long. We will not be taking any requests for teams or practice times. Please be understanding and know that not everyone will have practice times right after school. Practice times are dependent on the availability of the gyms and the coaches. Please be sure that your child communicates with their coach regarding any conflicts that arise. Students must attend school to participate in practices and/or games.

Study Halls: We will be providing a study hall from 3:00-4:00 PM. This will be held in Room 105, which is Mrs. Sheridan's classroom. This study hall is provided for any players who would like to stay and do homework and have a 4:00 PM practice. We are lucky to be providing this so please remember to have your child bring their work every day. If students do not want to do the study hall, they must leave the school and return at their practice time. There is no other supervision available for students who stay at school. Students are not allowed to stay in the gym to watch other practices or be in the halls.

<u>Games:</u> All games will be played at either HMS, CRA (we have two gyms), and possibly another school depending on the amount of teams we have.

The game times will be at 3:15, 4:15, and 5:15. The game schedule will be released after team placements are decided. Your child is responsible for getting to their assigned gym time for the game. The school and coaches do not provide transportation. There will not be practices on the nights of games. The game schedule will be emailed to you and will also be posted on the school website- under CRA sports. Please watch for emails!

We will try to announce when there are practice changes. It takes a lot of flexibility to make this work

for our students.

There is no supervision for students during basketball games or outside of their practice time.

Please only allow your child to be at CR during their scheduled game and practice times.
